





- These cards target the following spatial concepts: on, under, over, next to, beside, behind, between and in front.
- Have the student choose a card and tell where the tool is in each picture.
- There are 2 sets of 32 picture cards. One set includes the targeted concept word and one only contains pictures.
- Additional vocabulary to target with these cards may include: toolbox, construction worker, cone, barricade, wrench, drill, hammer, screwdriver.

Language goals that can be targeted by these picture cards:

- Identify and/or label spatial concepts.
- Create a complete sentence.
- ❖ Answer WH ("where") questions.
- ❖ Label target vocabulary.




